

Notes taken by J. Coburn on basis interview with 7/8/205

Below is account as told by [REDACTED] of [REDACTED] of ACTIVITIES ON DECEMBER 5, 1978.

[REDACTED] receives telephone call from American Section of Police Dept. Residence permit Bureau. AT 10:30 A.M. They asked her to come to office concerning ~~information~~ information about James Nytefer.

[REDACTED] went to office at 11:30 A.M. ^{AND} reported to the Head of American Section. The police officer asked for Mr. Nytefer's passport and residence permit. [REDACTED] ^{Fara} informed him that Mr. Nytefer was no longer in Iran. He asked, when he departed Iran. She told him he left on June 19, 1978. He then asked about Paul Bucha. She explained that Mr. Bucha ~~had~~ also left Iran and did not work here anymore. He looked very saddened and said "I suppose the other two are gone also." [REDACTED] ^{Fara} asked which two. He

said Mr. Chiapparone and Mr. Caylord. [REDACTED] said there were four files on his desk that he was referring to with their residence permit information in them, picture, etc.)

She said they were both here and she has just picked up Mr. Caylord's residence permit this morning. He told her not to give it to Mr. Caylord. He instructed her to act officially on his behalf and get Mr. Caylord's passport + residence permit along with

Mr. Chiappone's AND DO IT IN A WAY NOT
TO CAUSE ALARM ON THEIR PART. THEN
BRING BACK THE DOCUMENTS IMMEDIATELY.

[REDACTED] told him she could not bring today.
So he instructed her to bring in the
morning AND she was officially responsible
for this. He insured there were
witnesses to these instructions. She
left the office at that time.
