On Thursday 15 January 79 at Rezayeh :-

When the revolutionaries decided to check you out, did they succeed in calling Tehran? If so, what was said?

When you left the school to take the team to the hotel, did you at that time have permission for the team to go to the border? If not, what were you waiting for?

After taking the team to the hotel, why did you return to the school? What happened there - did you get permission to leave at this point? Why did you have the chauffeur write out the document? Why did he agree to do it?

After returning from the border did you go a third time to the school? If so, why?

When you returned to the hotel, did you have with you either a document or a revolutionary official to tell the guards to let the team go?

On the Turkish side of the border what were the problems preventing your leaving, and how were they solved?
