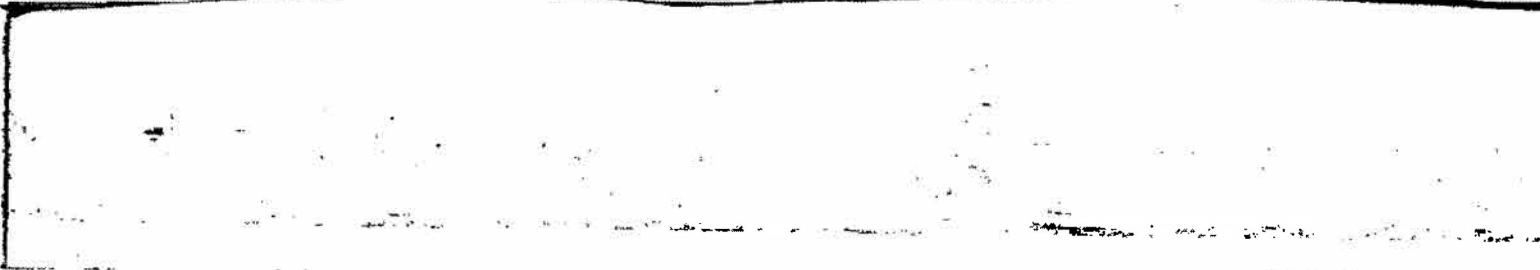

- 3/1965: Completed the IBM Programming class and moved into the Gemini Mission Controller group. Wrote numerous utility programs to aid in building and maintaining the Gemini Mission program package while training as a Flight Controller.
- 3/1966: Assigned responsibility for the Apollo 500 Reentry subsystem (Earth Orbital), for manning and operation of the Computer Dynamics Console during system tests, Flight Controller training and live missions following Apollo 500. Helped design and was responsible for the programs and methods of eleven programmers for the reentry subsystem.
- 8/1967: Lunar Return-to-earth maneuvering was added to my responsibilities along with trajectory calculations and impact predictions. Wrote numerous Fortran programs to aid in checking out test results, etc.
- 4/1969: Joined Electric Data Systems Inc. and went to their SED training classes because of lack of experience with IBM assembler (ALU). While attending this class I did several simulations using GPSS for the EDS software group.
- 7/1969: Completed the SED classes and joined the EDS software group where I wrote an online test application designed to allow complete checkout of the Recovery Management System being designed at that time. The application was made up of programs utilizing every online device and access method that EDS planned to use in all industry centers.
