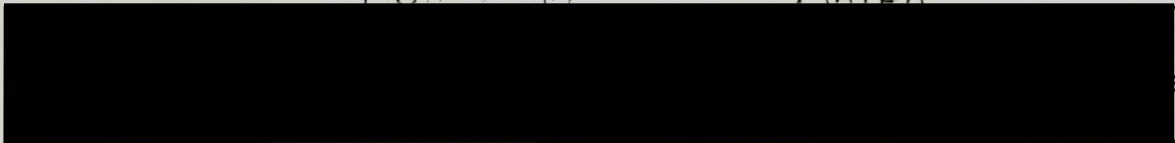

Practical experience gained while at CDI includes: Using CDC 3300 Machine Language, wrote, debugged and ran program on computer console. Programming with CDC 3300 Assembly Language, wrote a card-reader, line-printer and magnetic tape driver program which builds a master file on magnetic tape (blocked records). Using the Assembler and Operating System Language, designed a program to build a permanent master-data file on disk; card input and line-printer output being used. Program written in Assembler Language utilizing file creation and information retrieval. Specifically, the COBOL programs written encompassed building a permanent master-data file upon disk (an inventory application); updating the permanent master-data file previously built (file maintenance) and a payroll application in accounting and the associated arithmetic computations with a new master tape being written with the updated information. All COBOL programs written used card, tape and/or disk input. Programming an IBM 360 using BAL for card-reader to line-printer driver, saving and loan mortgage status, and random access master file update utilizing decimal and standard instruction sets. Performing matrix manipulating and sorting techniques in FORTRAN IV; learning operating systems for applicable IBM and CDC equipment; and applied system analysis.
