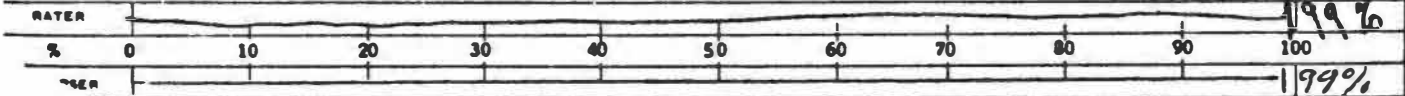
INDORSER I AM UNABLE TO EVALUATE THIS OFFICER FOR THE FOLLOWING REASON:
